HOST THIS CLASS

This course will help officers develop a process-based approach to handgun shooting and focus on the essential skills required to get their handguns in the fight as efficiently as possible.

Class starts at 8:00 AM, and the training days are eight hours long.

Range Drills

- Efficient duty gear set-up
- Shooting platform/structure
- Fundamentals of Defensive Marksmanship
- Acceptable accuracy based on target perception
- Understanding the balance of speed and precision
- Breaking down drills/techniques into component skills
- Critical incident reloading

Student Requirements

- Duty/Tactical belt
- Duty handgun with holster and three magazines
- Body armor or plate carrier - Mandatory
- **400 rounds of quality handgun ammunition**
- Packed lunch/snacks/hydration source
- Clothing for weather conditions
- Hearing protection
- Wrap around safety glasses
- Billed hat
